Investigate Programs

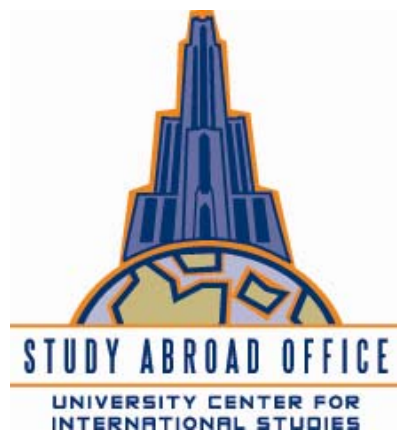

Approve Courses

Make sure your courses will be approved for your major or general education requirements before applying. Bring course syllabi and descriptions to your advisor.

Seek Other Sources of Financial Aid

- In addition to the faculty and staff benefits, students **may** be eligible to receive other forms of aid.
- Federal, state, and campus-based financial aid, with the exception of Federal Work-Study, will apply to study abroad. Those who fill out a Cost of Increase for Study Abroad form **may** receive additional aid.

Study Abroad is for Everyone!

Education Policy

The University of Pittsburgh encourages international study and endeavors to make available education benefits to eligible faculty, eligible staff, and their eligible dependents.

The eligibility and the benefits are on the same basis as are available for enrollment at each of the five campuses – Oakland, Bradford, Greensburg, Johnstown, and Titusville. Refer to Policies applicable to active faculty and staff and separated faculty and staff for reasons of retirement, disability, or death. On a limited basis, benefits are available on the same basis as are available to faculty and staff who fulfill the requirements for the program for benefits to other institutions, which was discontinued in 1994.

The benefits are applicable to tuition remission transactions which do not require a cash remittance to the institution where the study is taking place and/or the program through which the study is taking place.

(Education benefits programs are distinct and separate from the Tuition Exchange Program which is subject to the policies of the Tuition Exchange Program and as well the policies of the college or university where the student is matriculating.)

Please note: Final decision as to the eligibility for benefits for a specific program will be made by Faculty Records or Human Resources.
