Trovol to Mainland China	Students need to apply for a separate tourist visa to Mainland China.	
Travel to Mainland China	Students could make application through local Chinese Embassy before arriving Hong Kong or visit China Travel Service (H.K.) Limited (enquiry@ctshk.com) after arriving Hong Kong.	
Working in Hong Kong	Exchange students are NOT allowed to work in Hong Kong under Student Visa conditions.	

HEALTH / INSURANCE INFORMATION	
Medical Services	HKU provides free primary health care to full-time students at the University's out-patient clinic. Dental service is also available at a notional charge. Please visit http://www.uhs.hku.hk/ for more information.
Insurance	Health and travel insurance is optional but highly recommended. Students may arrange insurance at their own cost in order to meet their needs for the duration of their studies in Hong Kong. The coverage should include provisions for emergency evacuation, rescuer's expenses and repatriation. If you plan to travel outside Hong Kong, you should make sure that your insurance policy covers those destinations as well.
